

## **Dismissal from the Nursing Program**

If the nursing department faculty determines that a student's performance merits dismissal from the program, the Nursing Department Chair will communicate this information to the student in writing.

### **Students can be dismissed from the nursing program for one of three reasons:**

1. Failure to maintain 75% in all nursing courses required for the nursing major.
2. Failure to conform to safe and/or ethical nursing practices as stated in the Safe Nursing Practice Guidelines outlined in the Nursing Student Handbook.
3. Failure to attend a significant number of clinical experiences, skills lab and/or simulations as determined by the nursing faculty.
