

## **Progression in the Nursing Program**

### **In order to continue in the nursing program, the student must:**

1. Complete all course requirements.
2. Achieve 75% or above on the examination component of the course. If the examination grade is less than 75%, the grade on the examination component becomes the grade in the course.
3. Achieve 75% or above in the clinical experience component of the course. If the clinical experience grade is less than 75%, the grade on the clinical experience component becomes the grade in the course.
4. If the above criteria are not met, the student will be referred to the Nursing Department Chair.

### **If the above criteria are not met, the following actions may be taken:**

1. The student may be given the option of repeating the course. A student may repeat a maximum of one course in the nursing major one time. If the student is unsuccessful in repeating a nursing course in the major, the student will be required to withdraw permanently from the nursing major.
2. The student may be required to withdraw permanently from the major. If a student receives less than 75% in more than one nursing course in a semester or in more than one course throughout the nursing major, the student must withdraw.
